

WCHS Band Boosters Meeting

June 2, 2014

7:00 pm

President Charlie Zimmerman called the meeting to order at 7:00 pm. The meeting began with four boosters and Mrs. Parrott present.

Missy Zimmerman was Secretary Pro-Tem for this meeting. Minutes from the May meeting were read by members and with no corrections to add, Lisa Roberts moved to accept the minutes. Tammy Miller seconded the motion and the minutes were passed as presented.

**Committees:**

**Putting on the Ritz**

-Some reports still needed to complete the file on this project from 2014.

**Band Camp**

-Lisa Cantor-Wright submitted a shirt design and it was accepted by the directors.

- All other areas of camp have been discussed by the committee and are being worked on.

**Invitational**

-Jessica Bochart will co-chair this event with Charlie Zimmerman

-We currently have 14 bands attending.

-Of note, there is also a volleyball tournament at WCHS on Sept. 6.

**Uniforms**

-All uniforms were turned in by Memorial Day with only a few hat boxes missing.

**Chaperones**

-Tammy Miller clarified how many chaperones will be needed for competitions and night practices.

-Extra snacks from Memorial Day parade will be saved for use at competitions.

**Fundraising**

-Patron Program has received \$1,470 so far for the 2014-2015 year.

**Mr. Parrott's Corner**

-We had fourteen applicants for the tornado relief scholarships. This would total \$2,420 in fees used from donations after the storm.

-We currently have one diamond level patron for the upcoming year. It is from Avanti's.

**Old Business:**

-Irrigation for the band practice field will require \$900 for the ground work (trench, pipe) and \$1,000 for the hose. This could be less if a hose is already available at school that can be used.

-Boosters wanted to clarify who is responsible to overseeing the unit while it is running. This will be checked out.

**New Business:**

-Tammy Miller made a motion to approve the funds for those who submitted an application for tornado relief. Lisa Roberts seconded the motion and it passed by voice vote.

-Tammy Miller made a motion to approve up to \$2,000 for the irrigation project so that it can be completed before band camp. Lisa Roberts seconded the motion and it passed.

Charlie Zimmerman made a motion to adjourn the meeting. It was seconded, the motion passed and the meeting was closed.
